Dr. Gita Gopinath is one of the renowned Indo-American Economists. She is of Kerala origin, was born in Kolkata, and did her schooling at Nirmala Convent, Mysuru. She did her B.A. from Lady Shriram College, Delhi and M.A. Economics from Delhi School of Economics. She did her M.A. at the University of Washington and Ph.D. from Princeton University. She got the Woodrow Wilson Fellowship Research Award while doing her doctoral research at Princeton.

Dr. Gita is the John Zwaanstra Professor of International Studies and Economics at Harvard University and presently working, on deputation, as the Economic Counsellor and Director, Research Department, International Monetary Fund (IMF), USA. Previously she had been serving as the Chief Economist of the IMF. She is the Co-Director of the International Finance and Macro-economic Program at the National Bureau of Economic Research, Visiting Scholar at the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston, Member of the Economic Advisory Panel of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. She was named one of the top 25 economists under the age group 45, by the IMF. She was chosen as a Young Global Leader by the World Economic Forum.

Dr. Gita is an elected Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and of the Econometric Society. She is the recipient of the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman, the highest honour conferred on Overseas Indians by the Government of India, and, the Distinguished Alumnus Award from the University of Washington. She has been named as a top global thinker in 2019. She has guided more than 15 students for Ph.D. inspite of her hectic and demanding work schedule. She is an eminent writer in Economics and has published number of research articles, books and publications in various International Journals. She is the Co-Editor of the current Handbook of International Economics. She has also worked as the Managing Editor of the Review of Economic Studies.
