



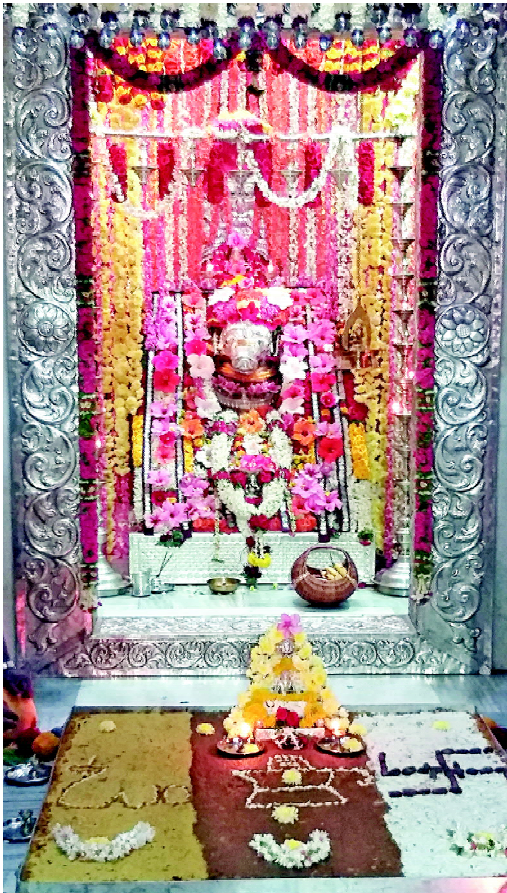

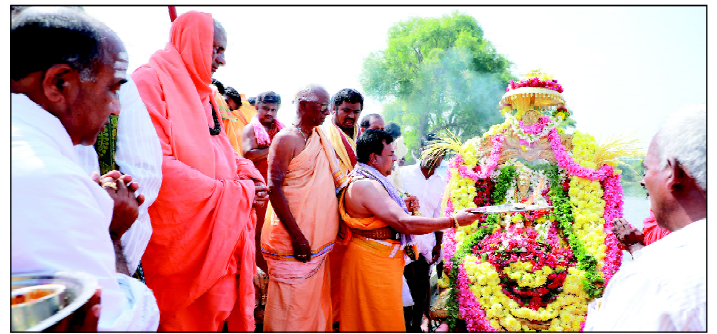
Jathra Purifies the Mind
